All equines must have current proof of a Negative Coggins Test

(all references to horse are understood to mean any equine being ridden)

I, the undersigned, do understand that there is a great deal of skill and experience required to properly enjoy the Equestrian experience of horse trail riding. I do further understand that due to the very nature of trail riding the terrain that may be traversed during a trail ride at the Ponderosa, at the rider’s option, may consist of flat ground trails as well as extremely hilly trails. I further understand that on many of the trails there are trees, natural debris and other obstacles present which must be navigated and traversed safely, which is solely dependent on the skill of the individual rider and mount.

I do further acknowledge that I have been given a trail map of the Ponderosa that indicates known areas of difficulty of the various marked trails and that by taking any particular trail I am representing that I possess all the qualifications, experience and expertise necessary to traverse that trail safely upon my mount.

By executing this document I am representing that I have no physical or mental disability, disorder or other condition that would prohibit me from safely and prudently riding my horse upon the property of the Ponderosa. I further agree that under no circumstances will I ride my horse upon the property while intoxicated. I further agree that under no circumstances will I ride double with any other person, nor will I allow any other person to ride double with me.

I understand that the type of mount to be used by me is solely my discretion (expect that stallions are not allowed) and that I will supply this mount. I understand that it is not advisable to have any carry-on objects of any type while engaging in trial riding. I agree that during any ride I will not scream, yell, make loud or sharp noises, that I will not hold my mount back and will attempt to stay with the group, that I will not ride ahead, leave the group, nor run my mount towards the stables. I further agree that there will be no slapping, hard kicking or jerking the reins or any other abusive acts towards my mount or any other while I am at the Ponderosa.

I understand that I alone shall be responsible for assuring that all my equipment is properly secured upon my mount and I agree that I will check the girth cinch tightness immediately before mounting and again within a ten minute period out on the ride.

I do further understand that the Ponderosa has provided barns/stables for my convenience in housing and caring for my mount during my stay, and I understand that caution and care must be utilized around and about the stable area. I will not engage in any type of activity or conduct in that area that would place myself or others at risk.

I do also hereby understand that Little Sugar Creek runs the length of the Ponderosa and that as such, it offers the opportunity to wade or swim. I hereby acknowledge the inherent danger of open water to myself and any minor children for whom I am responsible and I understand that there is no lifeguard(s) and that to engage in swimming or wading is done so at my (our) own risk. I do further hereby represent that I will exercise due diligence with regard to the risks associated with any activities involving Little Sugar Creek or any other body of water found on the Ponderosa and I do hereby agree to hold harmless T-C Ventures LLP, its owners, operators, employees, successors or assigns for any such risks.

Special notice concerning children: Children under the age of 12 years, children lacking seasoned experience with horses and riding, and children with behavioral problems or emotional, mental or physical disability must be under the constant supervision of their parent or guardian. As a general rule children under age 12, when in the area of the stables
